

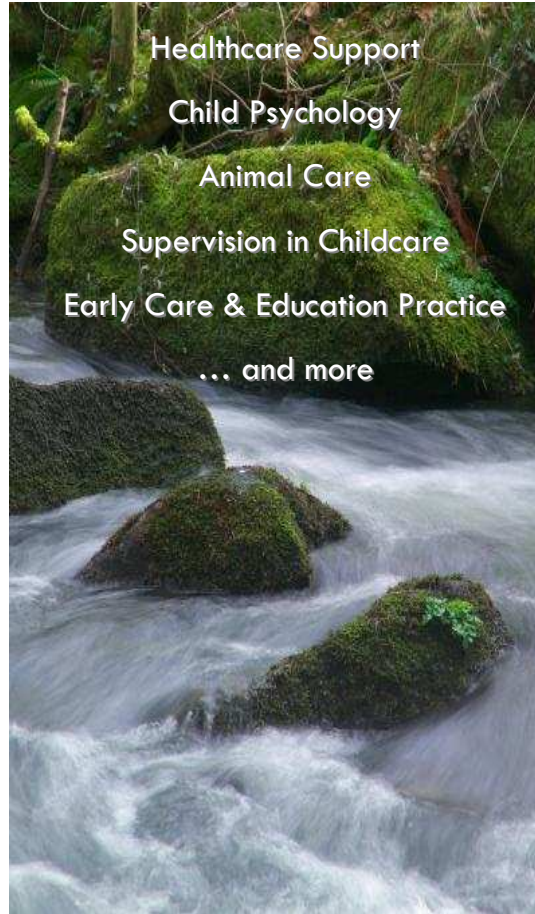

COMMUNITY CARE FETAC LEVEL 5 (5M2786)

If you are working in social services, respite care, community services, residential units, voluntary services, or as a home help, then this FETAC Level 5 course will be very beneficial to you.

You will be introduced to skills such as:

- ⇒ Care of the Older Person
- ⇒ Care Support
- ⇒ Care Provision and Practice
- ⇒ Safety and Health at Work

The Certificate consists of five mandatory Level 5 modules, and three optional Level 5 modules.

Twelve nights are devoted to each module. Classes run on Monday and Wednesday nights for 24 weeks. Students complete two modules per term and finish the course in two years.

Fee structure

- * Four modules per year over 2 years
- * Two nights per week
- * Individual modules €280.
- Eight modules: €1480. Includes €80 reg. fee plus four instalments of €350.
- * Candidates *must* arrange and complete a period of work experience.

Mandatory Modules 15 credits each

1. Care Provision and Practice (5N2705)

- Groups in need of care in the community
- Roles and skills in total patient care
- Planning for total patient care at home and work

2. Human Growth & Development (5N1279)

- Physical, social, and emotional development
- Explore own feelings about caring for others

3. Safety & Health at Work (5N1794)

- Safety, health and welfare at work legislation
- Accidents: causes, prevention, reporting
- Infection control and workplace hazards

4. Work Experience (5N1356)

- Career opportunities in your work area
- Employer, employee rights and responsibilities
- Reflect and evaluate work placement

5. Communications (5N0690)

- Interpersonal skills, listening, advocacy
- Verbal and non-verbal communications

OR

5. Customer Service (5N0972)

- Key features of good customer service
- Necessary skills, qualities, and attitude

You can join this course in January or September and complete the modules at your own pace
