Fee Structure

Option 1: €1280

Seven Level 6 Credits

Participants must complete 5 compulsory Level 6 modules, along with 2 other elective modules. You can use any level 5 module from a previous course to achieve the total of 8 modules.

Participants must have certification for the Level 5 module in place and must submit a copy of the certificate for this module to the Adult Education Office before the completion of the Supervision in Childcare course.

Option 2: €1480

Eight Level 6 Credits

Participants must complete the 5 compulsory Level 6 modules plus 3 other level 6 elective modules
Or 2 Level 6 modules Plus 1 Level 5 module.

If you are managing a childcare facility or thinking of working in childcare management, this FETAC Level 6 course is mandatory.
